

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF STATE, BUREAU OF HISTORICAL RESOURCES UNDER THE ACQUISITION AND DEVELOPMENT CATEGORY FOR THE EMERSON POINT PARK PORTAVENT MOUND COMPLEX.

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of State, Bureau of Historical Resources provides grants under the Acquisition and Development Category Grant Program for restoration activities for significant archeological properties; and

WHEREAS, the Portavant Mound Complex, which is listed in the National Register of Historic Places, and therefore an eligible property for funding consideration, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the Portavant Mound Complex is threatened by ongoing erosion, and

WHEREAS, Manatee County desires financial assistance from the State of Florida in order to preserve the Portavant Mound Complex.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, that:

1. The submission of a grant application to the Florida Department of State, Bureau of Historical Resources, for restoration activities at the Portavant Mound Complex is hereby authorized.
2. The Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairman are authorized to execute all appropriate documents with regards to the submission of this application and related documents required pursuant to the application.
3. The County Administrator, or his designee, is authorized to execute all administrative documents associated with this grant application.
