

RESOLUTION R-93-303

A RESOLUTION OF MANATEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE SARASOTA/MANATEE METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION (MPO) AS RELATED TO FUNDING FOR THE CONTINUATION OF PLANNING ACTIVITIES FOR A BICYCLE/PEDESTRIAN PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, has the authority to enter into A Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the MPO to continue a project as authorized by the Governor's Energy Office; and

WHEREAS, the MPO was authorized to pass a portion of the Federal Highway Administration (PL) Section 112 funds to Manatee County for the Bicycle/Pedestrian Coordinator Program in accordance with the Unified Planning Work Program approved by the MPO Board on June 28, 1993; and

WHEREAS, Sections 163.3177 and 335.065 of the Florida Statutes require the inclusion of bicycling facilities planning in local government comprehensive plans and full consideration of bicycle ways in the planning and development of state, regional, and local transportation plans and programs; and

WHEREAS, the Manatee County Comprehensive Plan, Chapter 5, promotes and encourages bicycling facilities, pedestrian ways and safety programs; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners approved the JPA for Job No. 13000-3820, through Resolution R-91-130, on June 11, 1991, which created the original funding for Bicycle/Pedestrian Coordinator; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, that:

1. The Agreement for TASK #3.09 of the Unified Planning Work Program which will provide \$11,000 for financial support for the Manatee County Bicycle/ Pedestrian Program.
2. The Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Manatee County, Florida, is authorized to execute the MOA with the Sarasota/Manatee MPO.
